Application

This policy applies to the whole Miller Homes business including all sites and offices.

Objectives and Commitments

1. To prevent pollution, injury and ill health.
2. To take all practicable steps to reduce the incidence rate of occupational ill health, accidents and other adverse incidents.
3. To minimise the risks of injury to individuals, damage of property and environmental impact of our work activities by thorough planning and implementation of appropriate control measures.
4. To continually improve our performance in safety, health and environmental matters, whilst complying with all relevant legal requirements and supporting best practice.

Policy

To achieve these objectives, the Homes Division will;

- Develop Management systems in line with the requirements of OHSAS 18001 and ISO 14001 as they affect our business operations.
- Allocate adequate resources and provide active leadership to ensure the policy will be fully implemented.
- Allocate specific responsibilities to our employees and ensure they have the necessary training, competence, instruction, supervision and authority to fulfil the requirements placed upon them.
- Appoint and consult competent safety, health and environmental advisors.
- Communicate as appropriate, information in respect of health, safety and environmental issues to those affected by our work activities, including our employees, suppliers and the public.
- Consider the procurement of land and the design and construction of developments, in order to minimise the risks from pollution, the impact on the local environment, the depletion of natural resources, the use of energy and the generation of waste.
- Monitor the implementation of this policy.
- Review this policy annually as a minimum.
